However, the latest Executive Order provides a few changes for BHMSD Fall Season athletic events. Attendance for the Fred F. Park Field (Football Stadium) increases as follows:

- Football Stadium - 500 presale tickets (parent/guardian & general admissions)
- Football Stadium - 125 presale tickets (high school student tickets)

For other athletic venues, there are no changes to the middle school and high school gymnasium attendance limits currently in place. Ticket sales (presale, vouchers, at-door, etc) for each specific event remains unchanged. Venue specific information will be shared prior to the start of the BHMSD Winter Season athletic events.
