The regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Bluffton-Harrison Metropolitan School District was held on Monday, November 14, 2022, with all members present. Also in attendance were Dr. Brad Yates, Superintendent; Julie Meitzler, Asst. Superintendent; Tammy Mechling, Corporation Administrative Assistant; Jessica Bricker, Corporation Communications Specialist; Steve Baker, Rick Mettler, Schlaura Linderwell, Administrators; Ben Dailey, Associate Technology Director; and Holly Gaskill, News-Banner representative.

President Thompson called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

President Thompson opened the meeting by recognizing our school buildings for the Veterans Day programs they held and announced fundraising events for the eSports team and the football program. President Thompson also congratulated the football team for a successful season, as this is the first time since 1988 that Bluffton High School has won the football Sectional Championship.

President Thompson noted there were no registered public commenters to speak at the meeting.

Dr. Yates reported on the IDOE Office of School Finance Full-Time Teacher Salaries and Benefits Report. Data was from the fiscal year 2022 (July 1, 2021 through June 20, 2022). BHMSD ranked above the target threshold of 45%, and will continue to focus efforts towards teacher compensation and benefits.

Dr. Yates reported on the Middle School Roof Replacement and Improvements Project. Carpet was installed over fall break in a large section of the building, with a few corridors to be completed over the coming weeks. In addition, preparations for a powered changing table for the Intense Interventions program was completed over fall break.

Dr. Yates updated the Board on the High School HVAC Guaranteed Energy Savings Project. Work has begun on the rooftop units above the gym. In addition, select units of fan coils throughout the building are being installed, with the aim of limiting the amount of student interruption. Remaining work will be completed over break periods and/or summer break.
