ESSER III Goals:

1. BHMSD special student populations will improve their growth and achievement in math and language arts.
 - a. Special Education
 - i. Utilize co-teaching models at both BHES and BMS during the 2022-2023 school year.
 - ii. Fully develop MTSS programs across the district and formalize transitions between buildings of students in the MTSS process.
 - b. High Ability
 - i. Increase dual credit licensed teachers by providing reimbursement potential for those seeking dual credit licensure.
 - ii. Increase professional development opportunities for teachers of high ability students.
 - c. Free/Reduced
 - i. Increase the number of mobile hotspots for students in need of connectivity.
 - d. All students
 - i. Enrichment opportunities
 1. Summer School Enrichment Programs - Summer 2022 to be evaluated and considered for Summer 2023.
During Summer 2022, ten summer camps with over 200 participants are scheduled to take place in July 2022.
Summer camps will be offered in the summer of 2023.
 - ii. Interventionists to support Math at BHES, BHS, and a ½ time Interventionist at BHMS for the 2022-2023 school year.
 - iii. Continue to grow the ACT/COM course which started in 2021-2022 at BMS to intentionally provide instruction in critical

thinking and communication skills to all grade 7 and grade 8 students.

- iv. Utilize an SEL screener two times per year to better support students across the district.

2. BHMSD will improve technology to remove barriers for staff and students.

- a. All teacher devices were updated in 2021-2022.
- b. During the 2022-2023 school year, BHMSD has developed plans to allow for synchronous instruction for at least 50% of the required time on any virtual day. This will allow us to continue to utilize virtual instruction as needed to accommodate weather issues at BHMSD. By developing these plans, all students will have the opportunity to continue instruction with their classroom teachers allowing for the greatest opportunity for success in their current coursework.

3. BHMSD will update building items to increase efficiency, alter a space for a new purpose to allow for additional learning spaces, or improve safety for all students.

- a. Sanitation purchases for cleaning and disinfecting
- b. Specific building needs determined by building principal
- c. Increase white boards at middle school to decrease any air quality issues
- d. Increase number of desks, chairs to accommodate new spaces and updating to bleach safe solution materials
- e. Modify various spaces to allow for social distancing
- f. Dehumidifier upgrade to decrease moisture in the school setting
